Scripture ReadingLuke 10:25-37.....Two persons

Just then a lawyer stood up to test Jesus, "Teacher," he said. "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" He said to him, "What is written in the law? What do you read there?" He answered, "You shall love your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself." And he said to him, "You are given the right answer; do this and you will live." But wanting to justify himself, he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

Jesus replied, "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell into the hands of robbers, who stripped him, beat him, and went away, leaving him half dead. Now by chance a priest was going down that road; and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. So, likewise, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. But a Samaritan while traveling came near him; and when he saw him, he was moved with pity. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, having poured oil and wine on them. Then he put him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. The next day he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said, 'Take care of him; and when I come back, I will repay you whatever more you spend.' Message 1 ... For whom has we become neighbor for 10 years? ... Pastor Chung

At the time of the opening worship of Women's Center for Migrant Workers, I gave message on the title of "Who is our neighbor?" Of course I don't remember what I said, but I can tell what we did for 10 years. Let's see how much we could become neighbor for migrant workers. Before we close the worship we will watch picture show, and you will find a lot of events in 10 years. Therefore here we are picking up a special issue, which we could not save in the pictures. And, I hope, our Center members still remember the issue and tell us what we did.

Dialogue1About Joy and Chris.....Drama group

1. Do you remember the big incident happened in October 1997?
2. Yes, Maru's husband Joy and his friend Cris was taken to Namyangju police station and imprisoned in Euijongbu detention.

3. At that time there were many Filipino groups divided by family and tribal relations. And they always competed for the power.
4. Joy's group was attacked by one of the groups and they violently fought against each other. I heard the fighting was held at the Joy's house. Unfortunately, one of the members of the attacking group was dead.
5. You know, all other members of both groups ran away. But Joy could not run away because it was his house. And Cris was there with Joy.
6. That's how Joy and Cris were taken by police and accused as murderers because the members of the attacking side became the witness.
1. At the first trial, life sentence was given to Joy and 5 years in prison to Cris by the prosecutor.
2. So we needed a witness to make them be released. Roly, one of our members who was also there, accepted to become witness.
3. In April 2, 1998, Joy was sentenced 7 years and Cris 3 years. Cris was also given a stay of execution for 5 years. So he was released from prison and sent home to Philippines.
4. Women's Center members became the neighbor to help Joy and started to sign up for his release, and we received 100 members' signatures.
5. Yes, in December 10, 1998, we sent it to the Ministry of Justice with Pastor's petition letter asking for freeing Joy from imprisonment.
6. How much we were excited when we received the answer from the Ministry of Justice! Of course it was just official letter to inform us that they received the petition letter with signatures.
1. Thank God! Joy was released on Feb. 25, 1999.
2. We found the Center was the true neighbor for him.
3. Center announced it as Good News in our worship order.
4. After this incident, we have trusted Women's Center and many Filipino members have been helped by the Center.
5. That's right. We have been thinking Women's Center as our home in Korea.
6. And many Africans were helped at the time of processing employment permit. Then Tangwa and Thanks were our close friends too.
1. Yes, we are sure that Women's Center exists as good neighbor for all migrants.

Praise Love is not only a word Altogether

1. Love is not only a word, loving, that means both words and actions. As a sign of God's love born was Jesus on earth, as sign of God's great love for this world.
2. Freedom's not only a word, freedom that means both words and actions. As a sign of God's freedom, gave Jesus his life, as sign of God's freedom for this world.
3. Hope is not only a word, hoping, that means both words and actions. As a sign of God's hope Jesus lives among us, as sign of God's sure hope for this world.

Scripture Reading Matthew 20:1-16 A person

For the kingdom of heaven, is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with the laborers for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. When he went out about nine o'clock, he saw others standing idle in the marketplace; and he said to them, 'You also go into the vineyard, and I will pay you what ever is right.' So they went. When he went out again about noon and about three o'clock he did the same. And about five o'clock he went out and found others standing around; and he said to them, 'Why are you standing here idle all day?' They said to him, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You also go into the vineyard.' When evening came, the owner of the vineyard said to his manager, 'Call the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and then going to the first.' When those hired about five o'clock came, each of them received the usual daily wage. Now when the first came they thought they would receive more; but each of them also received the usual daily wage....

Message 2... What kind of education has been done for 10 years ... Pastor Chung
 The scripture, Matthew 20 was the text for the Center's first anniversary. This tells us God prepares equal participation opportunity and equal rights to get daily wage to live. Our Center has been trying to create participatory worship by Center members. Experiences help grow people. Migrant workers need to grow spiritually, intellectually, and technically to become leaders after finishing their lives in Korea, when they go back to own countries. Let's see what the Center have done for this purpose.

- Dialogue 2..... Drama and WorkshopsCenter members
1. Do you remember our drama at the first anniversary celebration?
 2. Yes, I remember, the title was "Is there any work?" Ten years ago, it was not easy to find a secure job. This drama was made as the story of our lives in Korea.
 3. Our companies were very poor. Of course there are still poor companies now. But at that time almost all the companies were very poor.
 4. Therefore we wanted to help the company and received half salaries because we did not want to loose our colleagues from our factory.
 5. We learned a lot from the drama. Because we were discriminated as migrant workers in Korea, we had to help each other.
 6. Therefore at the second anniversary, on March 14, 1999, we made a booklet, "Love Unites Us." And T-shirts to show we are one family.
 1. Every Sunday we studied Korean conversation using a few written sentences in worship order. After community meal we learned how to read and write.
 2. We requested to have Night School. Then Center moved into Songseng

and started Night School for music, Bible study, Korean language and computer study.

3. Women's Center tried to train us very hard. I can never forget the leadership training workshops. We felt we could do something great.
4. Yes, it was enjoyable because we found our own characters. Even though sometimes it was painful, we regularly took these trainings.
5. I was shocked when I realized I had been discriminating myself only because I was a woman. I changed my sexual consciousness.
6. The workshops for Creating Happy Families gave us heartaches because our children are not with us here in Korea. But we learned how we should communicate each other.
 1. We cannot count how much we learned.
 2. No, no. We may not remember all that we have learned, but it is true, we are here to be changed.
 3. We were not outstanding persons before.
 4. But now we all are participating as presiders, scripture readers, story tellers and drama actors.
 5. We learned, if we were trained, we could do anything.
 6. We are free from the bondage of women as gender characteristics.

Praise Help us accept each other Altogether

1. Help us accept each other as Christ accepted us; teach us as sister, brother each person to embrace. Be present, God, among us and bring us to believe, we are ourselves accepted and meant to love and live.
2. Teach us, oh God, your lessons, as in our daily life, we struggle to be human and search for hope and faith. Teach us to care for people, for all not just for some, to love them as we find them or as they may become.
3. Let your acceptance change us, so that we may be moved, in living situations to do the truth in love; to practice your acceptance until we know by heart the table of forgiveness and laughter's healing art.
4. God, for today's encounters with all who are in need, who hunger for acceptance, for righteousness and bread, we need new eyes for seeing, new hands for holding on; renew us with your Spirit; God, free, us make us one!

Message 3 Where do we go from here? Pastor Chung

I thank Women Church to support me to start this Center and continue until today. I also thank PROK, North Kyunggi presbytery to accept Migrant Women Church as a member. And I thank Kyunggi province to support us through many kinds of projects; I also thank other NGO supporting groups. Lastly, but most importantly, I thank the members of Migrant Women Church to support it. Without all these supports it was not possible to continue the Center. And now we are planning to

stretch our hands to migrant women, who came into Korea by international marriage, for they are now the least in Korea. Of course we will go together with migrant workers and international marriage migrant women. We confess that God is already waiting for us to be with them. So let's go together.
